The team flew to Ontario for the Toronto Snowmobile Show not knowing what to expect and left feeling positive from the favourable response.

Spending his days outdoors with people who enjoy the same things he does is immensely fulfilling for Clark. His sense of adventure is satiated by heading out into the mountains to find new places to sled.
